



The Commonwealth Club - DRESS CODE

The Board requires Members, Visitors and Guests to be dressed in a manner consistent with the character and standing of the Club.

DEFINITION OF MINIMUM STANDARD DRESS CODES

FORMAL

Men: Tuxedo, black tie, dress shoes.

Women: Dress to the formality of the occasion.

All: National Dress and Military Uniform.

TRADITIONAL BUSINESS ATTIRE/ SEMI-FORMAL

Men: Lounge suit or trousers and jacket, collared long sleeve shirt tucked in, tie required.

Women: Trousers, suits, dresses, skirts and jackets.

SMART CASUAL

Men: Trousers including chinos and denim that is neat, clean, in good repair (no holes, tears, fraying, severe fades). Collared shirts with long or short sleeves, without dominant logo or overt messaging that may be considered offensive. Short sleeve men's shirts not permitted after 5pm. Jacket and tie not required. Non athletic shoes with a sneaker-like sole are permitted throughout the Clubhouse

Women: As above including blouses, skirts and dresses. Children under 18yo are permitted to wear polo shirts in the Clubhouse.

SPORTING ATTIRE

Can be worn on the Balcony areas after tennis, gym, cycling, fitness classes, walking or jogging until 5pm.

CLUB AREAS AND APPLICABLE DRESS CODE

Formal, National Dress and Military Uniform are acceptable throughout the Club.

Garden Room Dining, Lounge and Balcony

Areas: Business attire/Semi Formal or Smart Casual. Please note, sporting attire is only permitted on the Balcony until 5pm.

Club Accommodation: When entering and leaving the Club accommodation, members and guests may wear neat casual, including blue denim and sports clothing.

Club Functions: Each Club function will specify which dress code is applicable.

Private functions: Code is at the discretion of the host, within Club Standards.

Members and guests whose dress does not meet the requirements listed above may be denied use of the clubhouse and sporting facilities. Management and staff are instructed to advise members and guests if their dress is inappropriate.

Clothing or footwear that is NOT accepted in the Club Men and Women:

Clothing with slogans, distresses, ripped or faded pants, jeans or trousers. Fleece jackets, hoodies and exposed shirts with no collar.

Thongs and similar footwear. Trackpants, Lycra shorts, t-shirts, sport shoes except when in sports attire.

TRADITIONAL BUSINESS ATTIRE



SMART CASUAL



Traditional business attire or smart-casual dress is required throughout the Clubhouse at all times except when otherwise specified and for the athletic facilities

FORMAL/TUXEDO-STYLE



Formal/Tuxedo-style dress for Black tie events

PERMITTED - SHORT SLEEVE COLLARED SHIRTS UNTIL 5PM



Short sleeve collared shirts are permitted in the Club until 5pm

PERMITTED - TROUSERS INCLUDING NEAT CLEAN DENIM



Trousers including denim that are in good repair

PERMITTED - NON ATHLETIC RUBBER SOLE SHOES



Non athletic rubber sole shoes are permitted inside the Clubhouse

NOT PERMITTED - HOODIES, TRACKSUITS AND FADED DENIM JEANS



Hoodies, tracksuits and faded denim are not permitted in the Club

NOT PERMITTED - ATHLETIC STYLE SHOES



Athletic sole shoes are not permitted inside the Clubhouse

TRADITIONAL BUSINESS ATTIRE



SMART CASUAL



Traditional business attire or smart-casual dress is required throughout the Clubhouse at all times except when otherwise specified and for the athletic facilities

FORMAL/COCKTAIL



Formal/Cocktail dress for Black tie events

PERMITTED - TROUSERS INCLUDING NEAT CLEAN DENIM



Trousers including denim that are in good repair

PERMITTED - NON ATHLETIC RUBBER SOLE SHOES



Non athletic rubber sole shoes are permitted inside the Clubhouse

NOT PERMITTED - HOODIES, TRACKSUITS AND FADED DENIM JEANS



Hoodies, tracksuits and faded denim are not permitted in the Club

NOT PERMITTED - ATHLETIC STYLE SHOES



Athletic sole shoes are not permitted inside the Clubhouse
